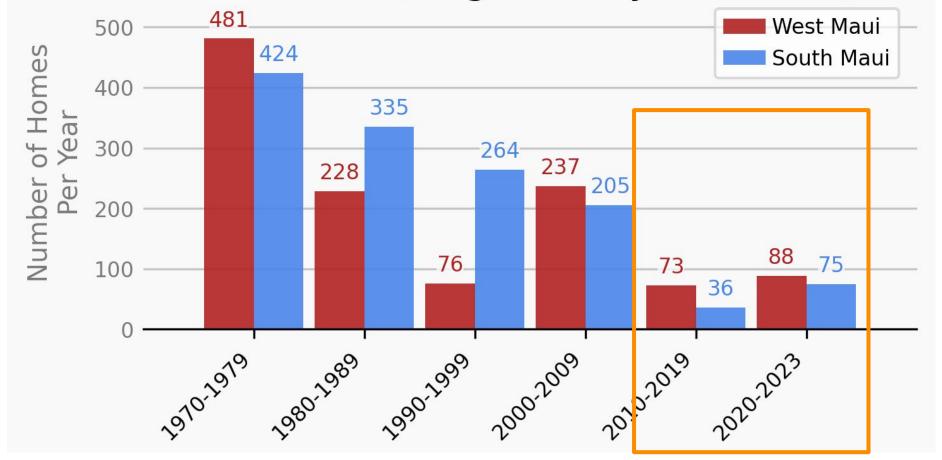






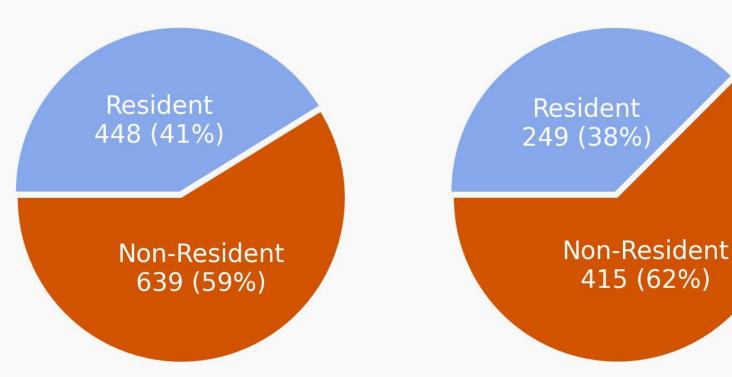






#### Residents of Homes Built 2010-2023

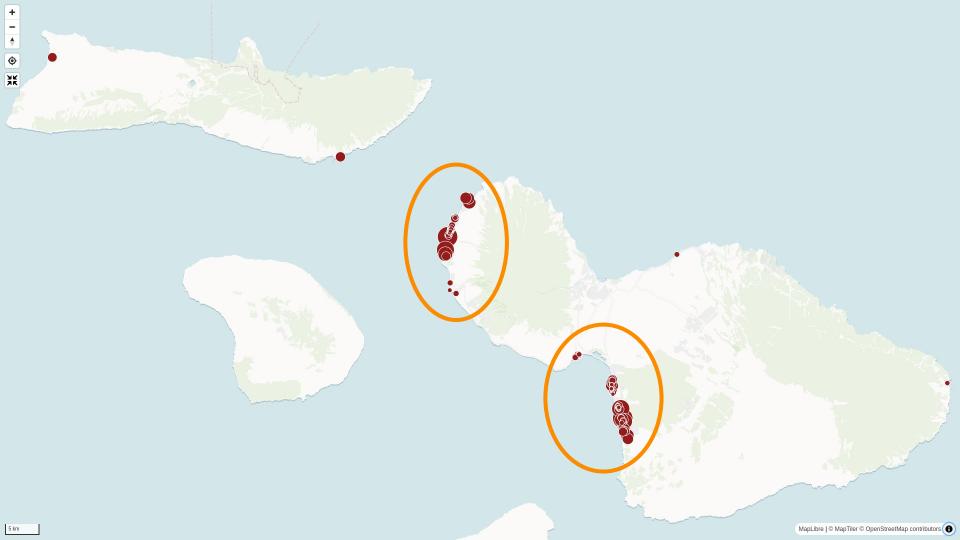

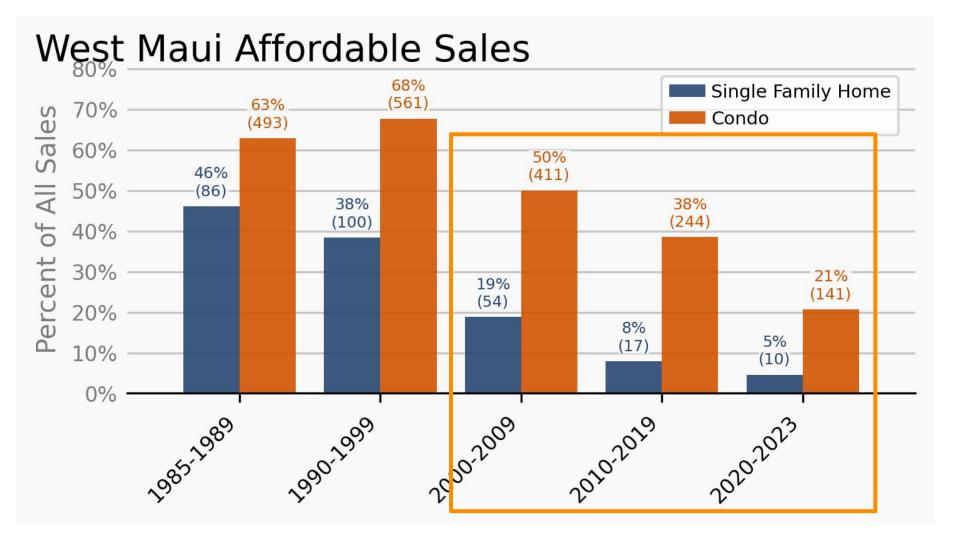
